I am requesting funding for Pace Randall Road Transit Signal Priority at Randall Road between Elgin and St. Charles, 60123 in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Pace Suburban Bus. The funding would be used to implement transit signal priority on Randall Road between Elgin and St. Charles, one of the corridors with the heaviest bus ridership in Kane County. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will make transit more reliable and more attractive by giving buses an advantage over regular auto traffic. The implementation of TSP can create immediate benefits to transit riders at a modest cost.

The project has a Federal Nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by chapter 53 of title 49 of the United States Code.
